## OBITUARY



Reverend Father Joachim Tan Kah Chye Born: 16 August 1945 Ordained: 26 January 1974

Departed: 22 October 2022

It is with profound sorrow that we announce the passing of Rev Fr Joachim Tan Kah Chye at the age of 77.

A resident of St Francis Xavier Home for the Elderly in Cheras, Fr Joachim was admitted to Assunta Hospital on Thursday, 20 October, after being found unconscious in his room. He remained in a critical condition until his demise on Saturday, 22 October.

Seremban-born Fr Joachim joined the St Francis Xavier Minor Seminary, Singapore in 1965 and continued his seminary studies at College General Major Seminary, Penang, in 1968. He was ordained a priest on 26 January 1974 by Archbishop Dominic Vendargon at the Church of the Visitation, Seremban.

Following his ordination, he was posted to his home parish, Church of the Visitation, as Assistant Priest. In 1975, Fr Joachim was appointed Parish Priest of the Church of St Aloysius, Mantin where he served for five years. In 1980, he pursued post-graduate studies in Rome and obtained a Licentiate in Theology.

Upon his return to Malaysia, he was once again assigned to the Church of the Visitation, Seremban, this time as Parish Priest.

Over the years, Fr Joachim served in several parishes in the Archdiocese of Kuala Lumpur and held terms as Senator for the KL North and Klang District. He was also an Exco member of the Malaysian Bible Society and Ecclesiastical Assistant for the Kuala Lumpur Archdiocese Biblical Apostolate.

Shy and unassuming, Fr Joachim will be fondly remembered as a soft-spoken, humble priest who was ever willing to give a listening ear and spiritual guidance to those in need. He placed much importance on the Sacrament of Reconciliation and could often be found in the confessional both before and after Mass.

He is predeceased by his parents and leaves behind a sister, a brother and a host of relatives and friends to mourn his loss.
